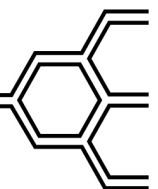
Dear Parents and Guardians,

Re: Flu vaccination clinics this winter

Ottawa Public Health (OPH) is operating a series of one-day flu vaccination clinics until mid-February. The clinics will provide continued access to the H1N1 and seasonal flu vaccines.

While H1N1 activity has decreased, it continues to be present in our community and the flu season will continue for several more months. Getting both vaccines will provide the best protection against the flu this year, and both shots can be given safely at the same time. If you or your children have not yet been immunized, I invite you to protect yourselves by getting the H1N1 and seasonal flu vaccines through the OPH clinics listed below or at many local doctors' offices, community health centres, university campuses and some workplaces.
